

NEWLY RELEASED TECH INNOVATION INDEX

In October, NC TECH released the 2022 Tech Innovation Index. The Index compares the state's metros' tech performance against other top metros in the country, as well as highlighted NC Metro areas. The methodology, developed with input from tech leaders, uses a list of metrics grouped into three subindexes: tech talent supply, tech talent demand and innovation. The data used to compare metro tech performance is released annually and will be used to assess year after year.
