

## MAY 11, 2023 PROCLAIMED NC TECHNOLOGY DAY

To highlight the significant contribution the tech industry has on North Carolina, Governor Roy Cooper proclaimed May 11, 2023 as NC Technology Day. Within the proclamation, Cooper highlighted:

- The tech industry represents more than 20% of the state's economy
- More than 340,000 North Carolinians across all 100 counties are employed in the tech industry
- NC has the 5th highest technology growth rate in the US, more than 2x the national average

- Research Triangle Park continues to serve as a world leader and the largest research park in the US

- The state continues to recruit highly qualified employees and innovative, top-notch companies because of the reputation and support for the workforce needed to support the tech industry
